
To All Attorneys Admitted to Practice
in the Northern District of Indiana:

The United States District Court in Northern Indiana is planning to implement a new automated case management and electronic case filing system, called CM/ECF, in late 2003. As a part of the implementation process, we are forming several committees whose purpose is to ensure a smooth transition to the new system. One of these committees is an Attorney Advisory Committee, which will be made up of attorneys who practice in this district in both civil and criminal cases, and from both the private sector and government offices.

The purpose of this letter is to solicit volunteers for the CM/ECF Attorney Advisory Committee. Magistrate Judge Christopher Nuechterlein will be chairing the committee. We anticipate this committee will be involved in reviewing electronic filing procedures, providing feedback and making recommendations to the court about the impact of electronic filing on the attorneys who practice in this district.
