GENERAL ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that no person other than the United States Marshal, his deputies, and authorized court security officers, shall be armed during any court proceedings in any courtroom of the United States District Court for the Northern District of Indiana, including its Bankruptcy Court, unless authorized by order of the presiding judicial officer of the court for a particular proceeding.

Officers of federal investigative agencies otherwise authorized to carry firearms may appear at initial appearances for the purpose of delivering prisoners in their custody to the court.
