ORDER

WHEREAS, this Court has determined that a United States District Court Library and Court Administration Fund should be established, and

WHEREAS, said Fund shall consist of receipts from admission fees paid by admittees to practice before the Bar of this Court.

WHEREAS, PURSUANT TO 28 U.S.C. § 1914(b) IT IS THE PRESENT PRACTICE OF THE COURT to collect a \$20.00 admission fee to practice before the bar of the Court, and agreed to increase the fee for admission of attorneys to practice to \$50.00 each, in coordination with the enactment of the Courts Improvement Act of 1966, the same to be effective December 18, 1996, and

WHEREAS, it has now been concluded by the Judges of this Court that the fee should be increased to \$60.00,

IT IS ORDERED that the said fee, be, and the same is hereby increased to a total sum of \$60.00, and that the Clerk's miscellaneous fee of \$50.00 be deposited to the credit of the Treasury of the United States, and the fee of \$10.00 be deposited in the United States District Court Library and Court Administration Fund.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to this Court's Local Rule 83.5(c) Pro Hac Vice appearance fees be increased to \$30.00 or half of the regular admission fee which shall be deposited in the United States District Court Library and Court Administration Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that monies may be expended from said Fund on behalf of this Court and its Judges by mutual agreement of the Judges for the purchase of books, publications, educational materials, and such additional expenditures as shall contribute to or benefit the effective operation of this Court;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that funds shall be withdrawn from the Fund by checks and withdrawal orders signed by the Clerk of the Court and countersigned by the Chief Judge.

This order shall take effect December 18, 1996.
