General Order No. 2010-9

ORDER

The distribution of criminal cases will be as follows:

(a) In the Fort Wayne Division, future criminal cases will be randomly assigned at the ratio of two (2) for Judge Springmann to one (1) for Judge Lee. Judge Lee will not be assigned any death penalty cases.

(b) In the Hammond Division, Judges Moody, Lozano, Simon and Van Bokkelen will share equally in the random assignment of criminal cases. Judge Moody will not be assigned any death penalty cases or criminal cases with more than three (3) defendants, or Medicare/Medicaid cases. Judge Lozano will not be assigned any death penalty cases.

(c) In the South Bend Division, Judges Miller and DeGuilio will share equally in the random assignment of criminal cases. However, any 28 U.S.C. § 2255 petitions or revocation proceedings arising from cases formerly assigned to Judge Allen Sharp will be assigned to Judge Jon DeGuilio.

This order supersedes General Order 2010-7 entered April 19, 2010.
