ORDER

Irwin Levin was appointed as lead counsel/interim class counsel for a period of one year beginning February 4, 2016, with the proviso that he may reapply when his term expires and that the court would appoint additional counsel to the plaintiffs' leadership counsel if and when it became necessary. *See* [Doc. No. 55]. Mr. Levin's term will expire before the stay in this case and the associated member cases is lifted on March 15, 2017. Given the progress that has been made toward settlement and the importance of preserving assets for the benefit of the litigants, the court finds that it is in the best interests of the parties to briefly extend Mr. Levin's appointment, so that he might focus his efforts on finalizing the terms of settlement.

Accordingly, the court extends Mr. Levin's appointment as lead counsel/interim class counsel for 60 days, to and including **April 4, 2017**, to provide continuity of counsel during the settlement process. Any application for reappointment should be submitted by **March 15, 2017**, and should contain

references to the nature and scope of work performed as lead counsel, including the time and resources expended in that capacity.
