

Frequently Asked Questions - USCIS

Q: How do we contact USCIS (United States Citizenship and Immigration Services)?

There are 3 ways to contact USCIS:

1. The website for U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services is <http://www.uscis.gov/portal/site/uscis>. There is a lot of information on this website, including Frequently Asked Questions. We highly recommend you visit this site.
2. Call the 800 National Customer Service Center at 1-800-375-5283.
3. Contact the office that interviewed you, either the Chicago or Indianapolis Field Office. Be certain to provide as much information as possible especially your name, address and “A” number (Green card number).
