**ADDENDUM TO THE AMENDED PLAN OF THE  
NORTHERN DISTRICT OF INDIANA  
PURSUANT TO THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT  
OF 1964, AS AMENDED**

**A FEDERAL COMMUNITY DEFENDER PROGRAM**

**A. ESTABLISHMENT**

1. Pursuant to subsections (g)(1) and (g)(2)(B) of the Criminal Justice Act (CJA), 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, the Northern District of Indiana Federal Community Defenders, Inc., a not-for-profit defense counsel service to be designated in this CJA Plan, is authorized to provide representation for the Northern District of Indiana. The Bylaws of the Northern District of Indiana Federal Community Defenders, Inc., are attached to this Amended CJA Plan.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, subject to the approval of the Judicial Council of the Seventh Circuit, the Amended CJA Plan for the Northern District of Indiana, this Addendum is hereby made to designate the Northern District of Indiana Federal Community Defenders, Inc., to furnish representation in the Northern District pursuant to subsections (g)(1) and (g)(2)(B) of the CJA and the *Guidelines for the Administration of the Criminal Justice Act, Volume VII, Guide to Judiciary Policies and Procedures*.

Upon organization of the Community Defender's office, the Community Defender shall notify this Court that he or she is available to accept appointments for representation.

**B. SUPERVISION OF DEFENDER ORGANIZATION**

The Community Defender shall be responsible for the supervision and management of the organization. Accordingly, the Community Defender shall be appointed in all cases assigned to that organization for subsequent assignment to staff attorneys at his or her discretion.

**C. MANAGEMENT OF CJA PANEL**

The Community Defender shall be responsible for the systematic distribution of cases to and for the management of the CJA panel subject to the provisions of the CJA Plan of this District, as amended

The provisions of the Amended CJA Plan for the Northern District of Indiana, last amended on July 31, 1980, shall remain in effect except to the extent they are inconsistent with the provisions of this Addendum, in which case the provisions of this Amendment shall govern.

This Addendum shall take effect upon its approval by the Judicial Council of the Seventh Circuit
