ORDER

Except as provided herein, cellular telephones will be permitted in the federal courthouses in the Northern District of Indiana, but must be left at the Court Security station at the front entrance, and may be used only at that location.

Building personnel and federal law enforcement officers shall be exempt from the foregoing restrictions, and may have cellular telephones in the district courthouses, subject to the following limitations:

Building personnel shall not be allowed to bring cellular telephones into any courtroom in this district.

The United States Marshal and all Deputy United States Marshals shall be allowed to bring cellular telephones into the courtrooms, provided the cellular telephones are switched to a vibrate (rather than an audible) mode prior to entry.

Visiting federal law enforcement personnel, who have been approved by the United States Marshal's Service, are authorized to carry cellular telephones

directly to and from the agency office they are visiting, but must deposit them there for the duration of their visit.
