General Order No. 2007-19

ORDER

The distribution of criminal cases will be as follows:

(a) In the Fort Wayne Division, future criminal cases will be randomly assigned at the ratio of two (2) for Judge Springmann to one (1) for Judge Lee. Judge Lee will not be assigned any death penalty cases.

(b) In the Hammond Division, Judges Moody, Lozano, Simon and Van Bokkelen will share equally in the random assignment of criminal cases. Judge Moody will not be assigned any death penalty cases or criminal cases with more than three (3) defendants. Judge Lozano will not be assigned any death penalty cases.

(c) Chief Judge Miller will be assigned the criminal cases in the South Bend Division.

This order supersedes General Order 2007-14 entered October 26, 2007.
