ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that in criminal cases documents which a party desires to file under seal, other than those specified in N.D. Ind. L.Cr.R. 5-3(c)(2)(A), must be filed electronically as required by the CM/ECF User Manual in Section IV. B.

Section IV. B. of the CM/ECF User Manual provides as follows:

In instances where a criminal case is not sealed, but a party wishes to file sealed motions or sealed documents, those documents shall be filed electronically in the CM/ECF system using the appropriate criminal events. A party must file a “Motion to Seal” or a “Motion to Seal Document,” prior to filing a “Sealed Motion” or a “Sealed Document.” Failure to file a “Motion to Seal” or a “Motion to Seal Document” will result in the striking from the record any “Sealed Motion” or “Sealed Document” that has been filed. These events will produce a publicly viewable docket entry but will not allow access to the attached pdf document. Any distribution to parties must be made conventionally on paper.
