

available through the PACER system;

3. By accepting this exemption, DPIC agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving the exemption;
4. The DPIC is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as the result of receiving this fee exemption, including redistribution via Internet based databases, unless expressly authorized by the Court; and
4. Unless extended by further order, this exemption is valid until 12 months from the date of this Order.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. Any further extension will be granted only upon a written request supported by an explanation of the limited scope of the research for which it is sought, the progress to-date, and the anticipated date of its conclusion.

The Clerk is directed to send a copy of this Order to the Administrative Office of the United States Courts and to the PACER Service Center.
