**General Order No. 2022-06**

**In Re: Application for Extension of Exemption from the Electronic Public Access Fees by  
Jonah Berger**

This matter is before the Court upon the application and request by Jonah Berger for an extension of his exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

The Court finds that Jonah Berger, an individual associated with a non-profit research institution, still falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, Mr. Berger has demonstrated that an extension of his exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Accordingly, Mr. Berger shall continue to be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this court through March 21, 2023, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of researching how the language lawyers use impacts the decisions juries reach. Mr. Berger shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this court. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

- I. this fee exemption applies only to Jonah Berger, PACER Account No. 6710677, and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
- II. this fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this court that are available through the PACER system;
- III. by accepting this exemption, Mr. Berger agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption;
- IV. Mr. Berger is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet-based databases;
- V. this exemption is valid through March 21, 2023.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.
