General Order No. 2026-01

In Re: Application for Exemption from the Electronic Public Access Fees by Tian Heong Chan

This matter is before the Court upon the application and request by Professor Tian Heong Chan for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

The Court finds that Professor Tian Heong Chan, an individual associated with a non-profit research institution, falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, Professor Chan has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Accordingly, Professor Chan shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of conducting research into the 2008 Egyptian Goddess v. Sisa case rulings and its heterogenous effects on design patent valuation, litigation likelihood, firm value and firm innovation strategy. Professor Chan shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this court. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

- I. this fee exemption applies only to Tian Heong Chan, PACER Account No. 8809464, and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
- II. this fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this court that are available through the PACER system;
- III. by accepting this exemption, Tian Heong Chan agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption;
- IV. Tian Heong Chan is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet-based databases;
- V. this exemption is valid from December 17, 2025 through February 17, 2026.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.
