MEMORANDUM OF APRIL 4, 2019 STATUS CONFERENCE

Irwin Levin appeared for the plaintiffs; Claudia McCarron appeared for the defendant, Medical Informatics Engineering; and Doug Swetnam appeared on behalf of the multi-state Attorney General's Offices in 3:18-CV-969.

The parties informed the court that progress has been made toward resolution of these cases and that Medical Informatics Engineering has received a proposed resolution plan from the Health and Human Services' Office of Civil Rights. Ms. McCarron requested that the stay be extended to provide the additional time needed to resolve that matter. While plaintiffs' lead counsel in MDL 2667 objected to a lengthy stay, all parties agreed to a brief extension of the stay.

Accordingly, the stay was extended through May 2, 2019, with the understanding that the stay will be lifted and discovery will commence if no agreement in principle is reached between MIE and the Office of Civil Rights. Plaintiffs' Lead Counsel was directed to file a motion for reappointment prior to the expiration of his current term on April 23, 2019; and a status conference was set for Thursday, May 2, 2019, at 1:15 p.m. (E.D.T.).
