ORDER REAPPOINTING LEAD COUNSEL/INTERIM CLASS COUNSEL

Irwin Levin was appointed as plaintiffs' Lead Counsel and Interim Class Counsel for a period of one year beginning February 4, 2016, with the proviso that he could reapply when his term expired and that the court would appoint additional counsel to the plaintiffs' leadership counsel if and when it became necessary. *See* [Doc. No. 55]. Mr. Levin's term was continued until April 4, 2017 to provide continuity of counsel during the settlement process [Doc. No. 102], and on March 15, Mr. Levin filed an application for reappointment as plaintiffs' sole lead counsel [Doc. No. 107].

Given the progress that has been made toward settlement and the importance of preserving assets for the benefit of the litigants, I find that it is in the best interest of the parties to grant Mr. Levin's application for reappointment, so that he might focus his efforts on finalizing the terms of settlement.

Accordingly, I reappoint Irwin B. Levin of Cohen & Malad, L.L.P., One Indiana Square, Suite 1400, Indianapolis, IN 46204, as Lead Counsel and Interim Class Counsel for a period of one year.

This appointment is of a personal nature, so Mr. Levin can't be substituted by other attorneys, including members of his law firm, to perform Lead Counsel's exclusive functions without my prior approval. I will consider appointing additional counsel to the plaintiffs' leadership structure, if necessary, following resolution of the settlement negotiations.
